There are legitimate claim agents.

Three types of VA accreditation to look for:

- VA-recognized and trained Veterans Service Organizations, who are free.
- Attorney in good standing with a state bar.
- Claim Agent who undergoes a character review by VA and passes VA's written exam.
- Note: Accredited attorneys and agents may charge fees, limited by law, only after VA has issued an initial claim decision.

- · Dec. 13 is the birthday of the National Guard.
- The National Guard has Participated in Every Major U.S. Conflict; since 1636.
- National Guard Members Swear to Uphold Two Constitutions; the U.S. Constitution and their individual state's constitution.
- There are Special Forces Units in the National Guard; 2 Special Forces groups and Air Force Pararescue.
- There Are Over 400,000 Members of the National Guard
- There have been over 780,000 mobilizations of National Guard units since September 11, 2001. They provided about half of the troops to Afghanistan and Iraq.
- American Samoa is the only territory of the U.S. to not have a National Guard unit. They have the only Army Reserve Infantry battalion.
- The Washington, D.C., National Guard is the only federal militia in the National Guard. It is controlled by the president.
- Three of the first five U.S. Army divisions to enter World War I were from the National Guard.
- The National Guard is mostly Combat Arms while the Army Reserves is mostly Combat Support and Combat Service Support.
